PROFESSIONAL BIOGRAPHY & SHORT SUMMARY OF RESEARCH INTERESTS

- Dr. Daria Smirnova currently acts as a Director of the International Centre for Education and Research in Neuropsychiatry (ICERN) of Samara State Medical University. Dr. Smirnova also works as a consultant in adult psychiatry and psychotherapy.
- Dr. Smirnova has been a lecturer for undergraduate and postgraduate students in the field of psychiatry since 2006, working as an Assistant Professor (till 2010). Afterwards she was promoted to the position of Associate Professor (2020) and the ICERN Director (2021) based on the academic achievements and experience of international collaboration. Her career background includes basic training in General Medicine (MD, Honours Diploma) with postgraduate course in Psychiatry (Samara State Medical University) and research experience (PhD, Medical Sciences, Psychiatry, Moscow Research Institute of Psychiatry).
- Main research interests of Dr. Smirnova focus on Affective disorders and Schizophrenia, in particular, the psycholinguistic approach related to these mental disorders. Scientific background includes a PhD program on early recognition of depression using linguistic diagnostic markers.
- In 2012 Dr. Smirnova participated in the international project on language dysfunction and compensatory resources of second language acquisition in a population of Russian-Hebrew bilinguals with schizophrenia (PI – Professors Haim Belmaker, Yuly Bersudsky, Joel Walters, Jonathan Fine; Ben-Gurion University of Negev, Bar-Ilan University, Israel).
- In 2014 she was awarded GoEight European fellowship to continue her research on thought, language and communication dysfunction in English-speaking patients using the Western Australian Family Study Schizophrenia dataset (PI - Professors Assen Jablensky, Johanna Badcock; Centre for Clinical Research in Neuropsychiatry, University of Western Australia, Australia) and acted as a Visiting Research fellow via contract (2015-2020).
- Dr. Smirnova coordinated several international multi-centre studies, in particular, as the project coordinator for "Estimating COVID-19 outbreak on mental health in general population across 40 countries" COMET Big Data Study (PI- Professor Kostas N. Fountoulakis; Thessaloniki University, Greece). Currently, she is a Principal Investigator (PI) of the "Innovative Neuropsychiatry Research Bank: Priority-2030" (In-Psy-ReSearch: Priority-2030) multidisciplinary project.
- Since 2010 she published more than 100 peer-review papers, including 63 articles indexed in Scopus database, as well as 10 book chapters and books (e.g., "Schizophrenia and Bilingualism", "Language Impairments in Dementia: From Word-Finding Difficulties to Everyday Conversation in a Dementia-Friendly Community", "Evidence-Based Outcome for the Interventions in Childhood-Onset Schizophrenia", "COVID-19 Pandemic: Mental health, life habit changes and social phenomena", "Comprehensive Management of Violence Against Women: Putting WHO Recommendations Into Practice", and others) for the international academic editions (Springer, Taylor & Francis, Routledge, Oxford Uni Press, and others).
- In 2019 Dr. Smirnova received a prestigious research award of the European Psychiatric Association (EPA 2019 Research Prize Winner) for publishing the best academic paper in the category "Clinical psychopathology and refinement of psychiatric diagnostic categories" (Smirnova et al. Language patterns discriminate mild depression from normal sadness and euthymic state, *Frontiers in Psychiatry*, 2018; 27th European Congress of Psychiatry, Warsaw, Poland, April 6-9th 2019).
